RE: New Prescriptions for Schedule II Controlled Substances

MEMO: Effective November 1<sup>st</sup>, 2021 Northpointe's psychiatric providers will not prescribe any adult (18 years of age and older) a new schedule II-controlled substance. Northpointe providers may choose to continue to prescribe a schedule II-controlled substance for those adults who are under the care of the provider as clinically appropriate.

Substances in this schedule have a high potential for abuse which may lead to severe psychological or physical dependence. It is in the best interest of those we serve not to begin treatment with this class of medication.

Examples of schedule II-controlled substances are listed below (not all-inclusive list):

- Fentanyl
- Daytrana
- Hydrocodone
- Oxycodone (OxyContin)
- Norco/Vicodin
- Adderal/Adderal XR
- Demerol
- Lorcet
- Morphine/MS Contin/Roxinol
- Percocet
- Vyvanse
- Concerta
- Dilaudid
- Lortab
- Methadone
- Ritalin
