Situation Details:

Boyington Place is an Adult Foster Care home located at 115 West Boyington Street, Iron River, Michigan 49935. This home is staffed 24x7. The home, the original pre-addition and new portion of the building, requires gutter replacement and repairs, to include soffits and down spouts.

Description of Work:

1. Contractor to procure Land Use Permit(s) from City of Iron River, if required.
2. Gutter Replacement Scope
 - Removal of existing gutters and downspouts
 - Carefully detach and dispose of old gutter system
 - Inspect fascia and soffit for damage
 - Repair fascia if needed
 - Replace or reinforce damaged fascia boards



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- Prime and paint as required
- Installation of new gutters and downspouts
 - Install seamless aluminum or specified gutter system (appx. 130 feet, 13 linear runs)
 - Ensure proper slope for drainage
 - Secure downspouts and splash blocks or extensions (appx. 80 feet, 8 downspouts)
- Final inspection and cleanup
 - Test water flow and drainage
 - Clean work area and remove debris

If Awarded:

- Provide timeline for actual project execution.
- Order Confirmation for Materials must be provided for Northpointe to meet auditory requirements.
- Letter of Agreement must be signed between the awarded contractor and Northpointe.
 - Will be provided upon award.
 - Business License and Insurance
- W9 for Payment, Certificate of Insurance, and License

- Northpointe is primarily Medicaid funded and must comply with Michigan and Federal statutes.
